Grants give kids boost

MORE than 20 local organisations have been given extra funding after becoming the successful applicants in the 2009 Woolworths Fresh Food Kids Community Grants program.

The grants were awarded to the applicants that demonstrated the best ways of getting primary school-aged kids involved in healthy activities.
