country/Jazz band and a sausage sizzle (put on by the NSW Rural Fire Brigade) while Cure Our Kids were presented with a cheque for \$11,000 raised through the group's recent fundraising efforts.

The tournament, organised by a group of 12 guys from within the financial industry, had an emphasis on fun and camaraderie, while raising funds for charity.

Patient Puppets

This miniature replica of real-life hospital equipment, is small enough to be placed on a child's bedside table, and will be used by the play therapist to familiarise kids with the often scary CT scan and other frightening procedures they must endure throughout their treatment.

The 2005 Christmas card range (illustrated by children undergoing cancer treatment) was a huge success, raising over \$70,000 for Cure Our Kids.
